

Applying to the Shiloh University

Before applying, we recommend the following steps to confirm that Shiloh University is a good fit for you:

1. Review *Degrees & Programs* and *Admissions* in the university website/catalog.
2. Review the *Technical Requirements* for the “online” learning forum.
3. Review the *About Us* section of the university website/catalog, including the *Statement of Faith* and *Accreditation Statement*.

To complete the Admissions Application Form, follow these steps:

1. Complete the Admissions Application Form. Original must include the student’s signature.
2. Write Personal Statements (page 5 - one paragraph minimum for each of the 2 points)
3. Write and include an essay describing your reasons for study at Shiloh University. Include in your essay how your degree will help you in your life and ministry. The essay must be typed, be between 300 to 500 words, and include your name, address and email address.
Note: No essay required for Personal Enrichment.
4. Complete the top portion of the Recommendation Form(s). Collect references and submit with the application or have them sent to Shiloh University. Please share pertinent information with the recommenders that will help them complete their recommendation letter.
Note: Personal Enrichment programs only need a Pastor’s recommendation.
5. Include official transcripts (for graduate and undergraduate programs only) or have them mailed to the Shiloh University. Include other test scores as applicable (see admissions requirements in website).
6. Send original application to: **Admissions, Shiloh University, 100 Shiloh Drive, Kalona, IA 52247**. Please also email it to: admissions@shilohuniversity.org to begin processing your application.
7. If you are not able to submit all materials together, please send in the Application form and personal statements to Shiloh University and communicate the admissions deadlines to those writing recommendations and sending transcripts.
8. You will be notified regarding acceptance, and if admitted, receive instructions on registering for classes.

Statement of Faith

Shiloh University is a Christian school, and all courses are taught from this perspective. Students must respect the beliefs and teachings of the school, may not take any actions contrary to these beliefs and teachings while enrolled in the school, and must otherwise obey the rules of the school. Refer to the *Statement of Faith* on the website.

Accreditation

The Shiloh University, as a new school, is not yet accredited. The school anticipates applying for accreditation over the next few years. It is important for prospective students to recognize that course work completed and degrees earned at the Shiloh University prior to its accreditation may not be transferable to another accredited seminary program, nor may they be marketable in securing employment. If you are enrolling in a master’s program with Shiloh University and are considering transferring to a doctorate program at another school after completion, check with the doctorate school(s) regarding transferability of credits earned at Shiloh University.
